
Thinking in black & white:

- only two possible alternatives
- is enhanced by majority decisions and dominant behavior
- but also by non-creative ways of discussions and decisions



Thinking in shades of grey:

- two possible alternatives and everything in between
- is enhanced by consensus decisions and methods of harmonization (moderation etc.)
- but also by non-creative ways of discussions and decisions
- and by basis-democratic methods in big circles



decision making from below

Creativity and autonomy:

- infinite options even at the same time
- encouraged by not needing to make decisions of everybody for everybody
- but also by creative ways of discussions and decisions
- and by the participation of all people and groups
- no need of mutual consent, instead you find diversity and solidarity
